

U.S. Embassy Santiago, Chile

The United States Embassy in Chile is located in a suburb northeast of Santiago. Progressive Consulting Engineers, Inc. (PCE) was selected to provide site civil engineering design for the complex.

The project included a 100,000 square foot embassy and consular building, utilities to serve the site, approach roadways, and the pavement for truck and automobile parking.

PCE prepared the plans for site grading, sanitary sewer, watermain (including rerouting of a 1 meter trunk watermain), storm drainage, and pavement design. The project was very challenging in that all the plans had to be prepared according to Chilean standards, which are in Spanish. All the plans were in metric units. Naem Qureshi, PCE Project Manager, visited the site to coordinate this work.
