

Minneapolis Convention Center, Minneapolis, MN

Progressive Consulting Engineers, Inc. (PCE) was retained to prepare the site civil engineering for the Minneapolis Convention Center. This was the largest single public project in the state of Minnesota at that time.

The site included numerous city blocks covering an area of 20 acres. The project consisted of 400,000 square feet of new building construction, new parking lots, approach roadways, curb and gutter, storm sewer, and sidewalk/walkways and a park constructed above an underground parking facility.

PCE prepared plans and specifications for grading, sanitary sewer, watermain, storm drainage, and pavement design. The downtown environment of the project required special attention to the site. Extensive cross sections were prepared to show how the existing Convention Center substructure would be incorporated into the new construction.

This project was very challenging in that the work had to be coordinated with several hundred professionals working on other aspects of the project.
