

Target Distribution Center Fridley, MN

Target Stores, commissioned Progressive Consulting Engineers, Inc. (PCE) to prepare the civil design for the expansion of its existing 376,000 square foot Distribution Center in Fridley, MN.

The site included a 56-acre addition to the 20-acre existing site. The project consisted of 696,000 square feet of new building construction, 20 acres of new paving for truck and automobile parking, a new approach roadway and the construction of a new guardhouse.

PCE prepared the Environmental Assessment worksheet, grading plans, permit application for the Watershed District and one for the Corps of



Engineers. We designed a 3-acre holding pond to retain storm water runoff. Our services also included preparation of plans for sanitary sewer, watermain, and storm drainage as well as design of a new truck entrance, truck and auto parking area, including the pavement design. Extensive cross sections of the site were prepared to identify poor soils. The quantity of poor soils excavated from the site were within 5% of our estimate.
