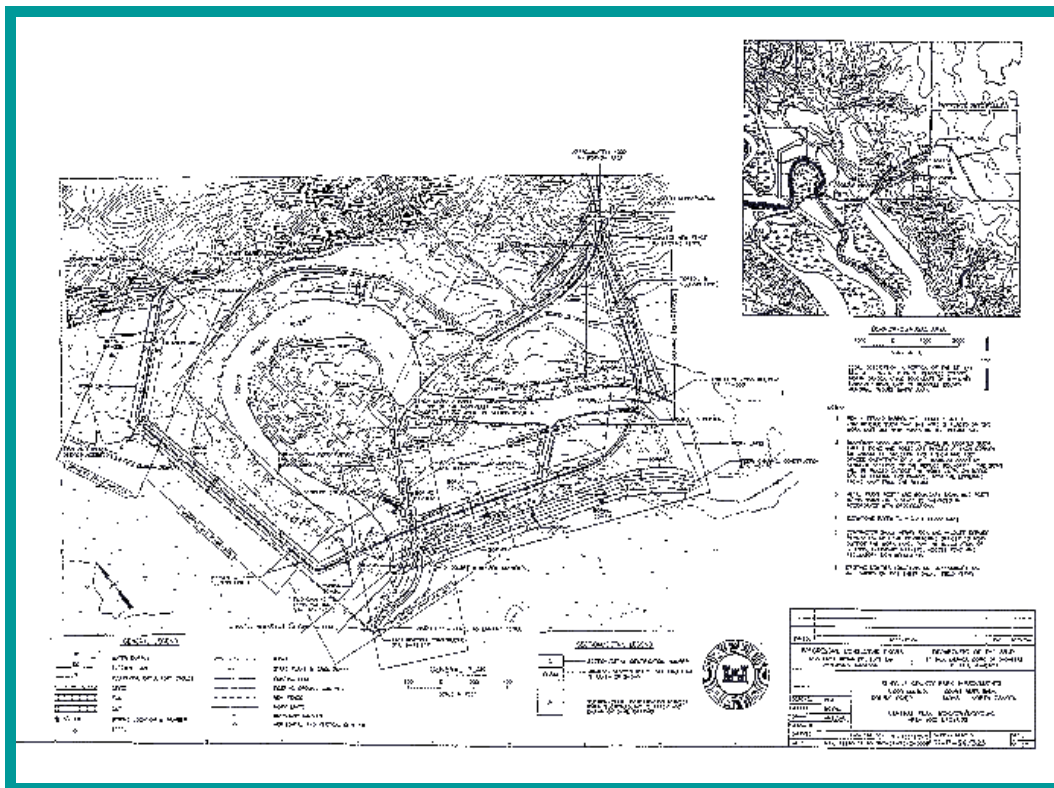


Renville County Park

The Renville Park Improvement in Mohall North Dakota was part of the Souris River Flood Control Project. The project involved the construction of 7,103 feet of levee, a stop log structure and a gate wall. The project included reconstruction of a roadway and landscaping to stabilize the levee.

PCE staff prepared the plans, specifications, and cost estimate for the project. The project was bid in 1992 and construction was completed in 1993. The bid price of \$1,115,827 was very close to the engineers estimate of \$1,117,000, a difference of less than 1%. The project was completed ahead of schedule with minimal change orders.

The project received a Merit Award under the Design and Environmental Awards Program in 2002.
